This is the 10th Anniversary of the WIN Neighborhood University Conference in Wichita. The Conference is expected to attract approximately 200 City of Wichita consumers and other individuals from around the State. Breakout Sessions will include five tracks: 1) Nuts & Bolts of a Neighborhood Association, 2) Curb Appeal and/or Community Gardens, 3) Civic Involvement, 4) Keeping It Fit and Healthy, and 5) Youth Involvement. Each year the conference is attended by a diverse group of grass roots neighborhood leaders and youth, non-profit and government staff, and others working in the field of neighborhood development. The one thing all attendees have in common is their interest in improving their neighborhoods by improving their overall health, living and relationships in these changing times.

The conference provides an excellent opportunity for communities from across Sedgwick County to come together and share their knowledge, experience and vision on how to make Wichita/Sedgwick County neighborhoods the neighborhoods of choice. While each neighborhood is unique, all neighborhoods face very similar issues and challenges ranging from the basics of organizing to addressing the complicated issues of public safety.

Wichita Independent Neighborhoods (W.I.N.) started with a few neighborhoods in 1993 and is currently a 501(c)3 that covers about half of Wichita households and over 60 Associations. WIN is in its 10th year providing the Neighborhood University Conference which serves to increase educational opportunities to empower citizens and consumers in neighborhoods to affect the health and safety of the community by increasing their input in zoning, fire and police protection among other important issues.

WIN is designed to encourage neighborhoods to come together for their own social engagement, to provide for their own common good and to become a safety network for that most basic social unit, the family. The WIN mission statement best describes the goal, “Providing education, resources and an effective voice for current and potential members of WIN on quality of life issues in Wichita and Sedgwick County”.
